Chairman NADRA Arshad Ali Kalim, Director General Post Office Mohammad Ahmad Mian and high officials of BISP also attended the briefing.

Farzana said funds are being distributed under the program in fair and transparent way, which she added, has been recognized at world level.

According to her, the Benazir smart cards would be distributed among the deserved people of selected districts

where survey on poverty has been completed.

She said transparency is the basic reason of BISP popularity, on which any type of negligence would not be allowed and this is the reason it is devising new payment system with the collaboration of Pakistan Post and NADRA.

Earlier, during briefing Farzana was told that the distribution of funds among deserved families through Benazir smart cards would be made easy but also health, education and other facilities would be made easy on modern style.
